Take ME-11/ME-100/Hartland/ME-152 (toward the Business District) down Somerset Avenue going past the Pittsfield Industrial Park and the Somerset Plaza. Continue toward town on Somerset Avenue to the traffic signal light at the intersection with Main Street. Take a right onto Main Street, go over the railroad tracks past the Pittsfield Public Library, continue on Main Street until directly across from Maine Central Institute, taking a left onto Peltoma Avenue. Follow Peltoma Avenue past the airport and cemetery to the Recycling Center/Transfer Station on the right-hand side of the road. The facility sits up on a hill. Travel up the road and you will see the wind turbine!
