

CORN HOLE TOURNAMENT

1st place- 50% of proceeds • 2nd place- new set of corn hole boards

Every player must pitch all four of his/her bags.

An inning is never completed until all players pitch all four of his/her bags.

Singles Play - Player A competes against Player B.

1. Both players stay in their designated lane for the whole game.
2. Players start the game at the headboard and will alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all four of his/her bags.
3. Players then walk to the end of their lane to the other court, take score, and resume pitching back to the other board.
4. The top of an inning is completed when the first player pitches all four bags; the bottom of the inning is completed when the remaining player pitches all four bags.
5. A foul point will not count. Any bag that hits the ground, another bag on the ground or if player crosses the foul line during throw.
6. Any bag landing on playing surface is 2 points. Any bag landing in hole is 3 points. After each inning points will be added. Player with most points will get remaining points after deducting opponents' points.

Egg-Lympics Rules

Rubber Chicken Toss: Mark a line and all contestants must remain behind the line and will have 2 opportunities to throw a rubber chicken. They may throw the chicken anyway they see fit as long as they don't cross the line. The participant who throws the furthest distance in feet wins.

Egg Hunt: (2-6 year olds) One plastic kiddie pool will be filled with sand. The participants have to dig through the sand to find three eggs and race back to the finish line. This will be a timed event and the winner will be determined by the participant who accomplished the egg hunt in the shortest amount of time. (7-11 year olds) One plastic kiddie pool will be filled with sand. The participants have to dig through the sand to find 3 jelly beans and race back to the finish line. This will be a timed event and the winner will be determined by the participant who accomplished the egg hunt in the shortest amount of time.

Watermelon Roll: (2-6 year olds) Mark two lines 50 feet apart. The participant has to roll the watermelon across the other line using ONLY their hands. This will be a timed event and the winner will be the contestant with the fastest time. (7-11 years) Mark two lines 100 feet apart. The participant has to roll the watermelon across the other line using ONLY their hands. This will be a timed event and the winner will be the contestant with the fastest time.

Egg Relay: (2-6 year olds) Two set of 5 cones will be set up 25 feet apart. Participants will partner up with someone else from that particular age group. There will be an egg on top of each cone. Contestants will have to run to cone and secure an egg between their chin and chest and run with the egg to drop it into their bucket. The team has to collect all 10 eggs in the bucket and cluck like a chicken. This will be a timed event and teams who complete this task the quickest will be the winners. (7-11 year olds) Two set of 5 cones will be set up 50 feet apart. Participants will partner up with someone else from that particular age group. There will be an egg on top of each cone. Contestants will have to run to cone and secure an egg between their chin and chest and run with the egg to drop it into their bucket. The team has to collect all 10 eggs in the bucket and cluck like a chicken. This will be a timed event and teams who complete this task the quickest will be the winners.

Water Balloon Toss: This will be like a traditional egg toss. Participants will pick a partner and they will stand 1 foot across from each other. Each participant will take a turn tossing their water balloon to their partner. Each time the water balloon is caught, they will each take one step back. When your water balloon bursts you are out. The winning team will be the last team with a water balloon that hasn't popped.

This will be held at the Warsaw Middle School Gym in the event of rain.
