1. It is hereby agreed by said Contractor that, for the year 2020 beginning June 01 and ending November 15 each year, he/she will perform, or cause to be performed, mowing of the following:
 - a. Fine Mowing per the attached diagram dated 03/02/05. Mowing will take place as necessary to maintain 5 inches or less or as requested by the Highway Foreman. This work will include weed wacking around the runway lights and signs. The Contractor is responsible to keep all tail grass down 25' in front of the runway rails. Grass must be cut back 50' around the lights (VASI/PAP1).
 - b. Bush Hogging/Farming per the attached diagram dated 03/02/05. Bush hog two (2) times per year as requested by the Highway Foreman. Contractor must cut all the areas between woods and pavement. Contractor is responsible to cut/bush hog tall grass/alders behind the tie downs. If the areas are too wet to cut, the Contractor must come back and mow at a later date; within five (5) days of being

called by the Highway Foreman. Contractor is responsible to make a few passes on each side of the road to the seaplane base. The grass must be mowed around the seaplane base landing.

All equipment necessary for this work is to be furnished by said Contractor.

2. It is further agreed and understood between the parties hereto that this quote will only become an effective contract when approved by the Town Council and an actual contract is signed and witnessed at the Pittsfield Town Office.
3. The Contractor shall perform the work described in the specifications and contract to the satisfaction of the Town in compliance with all known laws, rules, and regulations, provided however, that it is understood and agreed by the parties hereto, that if the service contemplated under this agreement should be performed in a manner not acceptable to the Town, as determined by review of the Highway Foreman, and remains uncorrected by the Contractor after oral and written notice by the Town as detailed below, this agreement may be unilaterally terminated by the Town.

In the event of reports of dissatisfaction with any aspect of the Contractor's work reasonably expected under this agreement, the following procedure will be followed:

1. **The Highway Foreman will investigate the complaint and, in his/her sole discretion, if he/she believes the complaint is valid he/she shall immediately telephone the Contractor and ask the Contractor to remedy the situation.**
2. **If the situation has not been rectified within two (2) days of the time the telephone call has been placed, the Highway Foreman shall send the Contractor a written demand that the situation be corrected within three (3) days of the mailing of the notice or any payments due under the contract will be suspended. After the three (3) day period, the Town will, if necessary, have the remedial work performed by another Contractor and deduct the costs of that work from any Payment due the original Contractor.**
3. **If the issue cannot be resolved, the Town will, within ten (10) days give notice to the Contractor, by certified mail, terminating the Agreement and the parties shall be discharged of their obligations under this agreement and have no further liability to each other.**



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
